Founded Prison Mindfulness Institute (aka Prison Dharma Network) in 1989, the international association for secular mindfulness-based prison programming and contemplative and Buddhist inspired prison meditation programs, with over 185 organizational members and over 4000 individual members.

Co-founded the Center for Mindfulness in Corrections in 2008, a division of Prison Mindfulness Institute, providing mindfulness and emotional intelligence based staff development, resiliency and leadership training for the corrections professionals and correctional agencies.
